This is the Privacy Policy (last updated 10 February 2021) for services offered by Menuridae Translating and Editing ('Menuridae', 'we', 'us' and 'our'), ABN 23 815 268 249, through the website www.menuridae.com. We respect your right to privacy and are committed to safeguarding your personal information. Menuridae adheres to the Australian Privacy Principles contained in the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth).

This policy sets out information on:

- a) the personal information we collect and how we collect it;
- b) the purposes for which we use your personal information;
- c) the circumstances under which we may share your personal information with others; and
- d) what control and information rights you may have.

By providing us with personal information, you consent to the terms of this Privacy Policy and the types of dealings covered by this Policy

#### 1. Personal Information

1.1 "**Personal Information**" is information we hold which can identify you or which is identifiable as being about you.

#### 2. Collection of Personal Information

- 2.1 Menuridae may ask you for, or you may voluntarily submit, Personal Information when you access our website, when we provide our services to you and when you interact with us electronically, in person or over the phone.
- 2.2 The Personal Information we collect could include, but is not limited to:

### 3. Security of your personal information

3.1 Menuridae is committed to ensuring the security of your personal information. We have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial

- procedures to safeguard the information we collect and protect it from misuse, interference, loss and unauthorised access, modification and disclosure.
- 3.2 Although we take measures to safeguard against unauthorised dealings with your personal information, we cannot guarantee that personal information we collect will not be handled in a manner that is inconsistent with this Privacy Policy. - 5.2 We may disclose your Personal Information to our employees, officers, insurers, professional advisers, agents, suppliers or contractors, but only insofar as reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy, or for us to carry on our business.
- 5.3 We may disclose your Personal Information where required by law, including:
  - a) to comply with an act, regulation, court order, subpoena or warrant;
  - b) in the course of a legal proceeding; or
  - c) in response to a law enforcement agency request.
- 5.4 We may disclose your personal information where this is reasonably necessary to protect the integrity of our website, and to protect the legal rights, property or safety of Menuridae, our clients or third parties.
- 5.5 We may transfer your Personal Information in connection with a change of control in our business or a sale or transfer of business assets.
- 5.6 Where we disclose your Personal Information to third parties, we will:
  - a) request that the third party follow this Privacy Policy in dealing with your Personal Information; or

b) take reasonable measures to ensure that the third party has policies in place that provide a level of protection not less than that provided under this Privacy Policy.

#### 6. Cross-border data transfers

From time to time, the Personal Information we collect may be stored, processed or transferred between parties (e.g. on servers) located in countries outside of Australia. In such cases, we will take reasonable measures to ensure that such overseas parties have policies in place that provide a level of protection not less than that provided under this Privacy Policy.

# 8. Technology and Privacy

#### 8.1 Cookies

- a) We may from time to time use cookies on our website. Cookies are very small files which a website uses to identify you when you come back to the site and to store details about your use of the site. We do not use cookies to automatically retrieve Personal Information from your computer without your knowledge.
- b) Our website may use cookies to customise your visit, facilitate and enhance website communication and interaction, and for other purposes to make your visit more convenient or to enable us to enhance our service.
